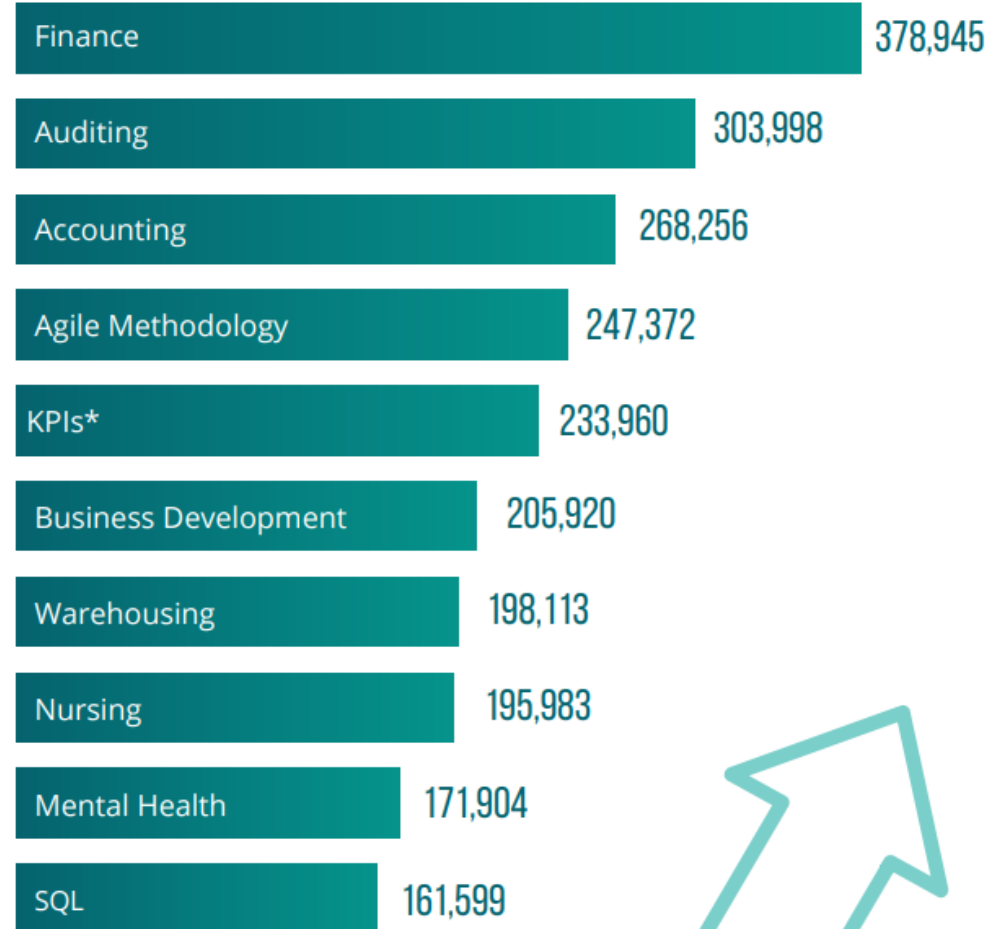

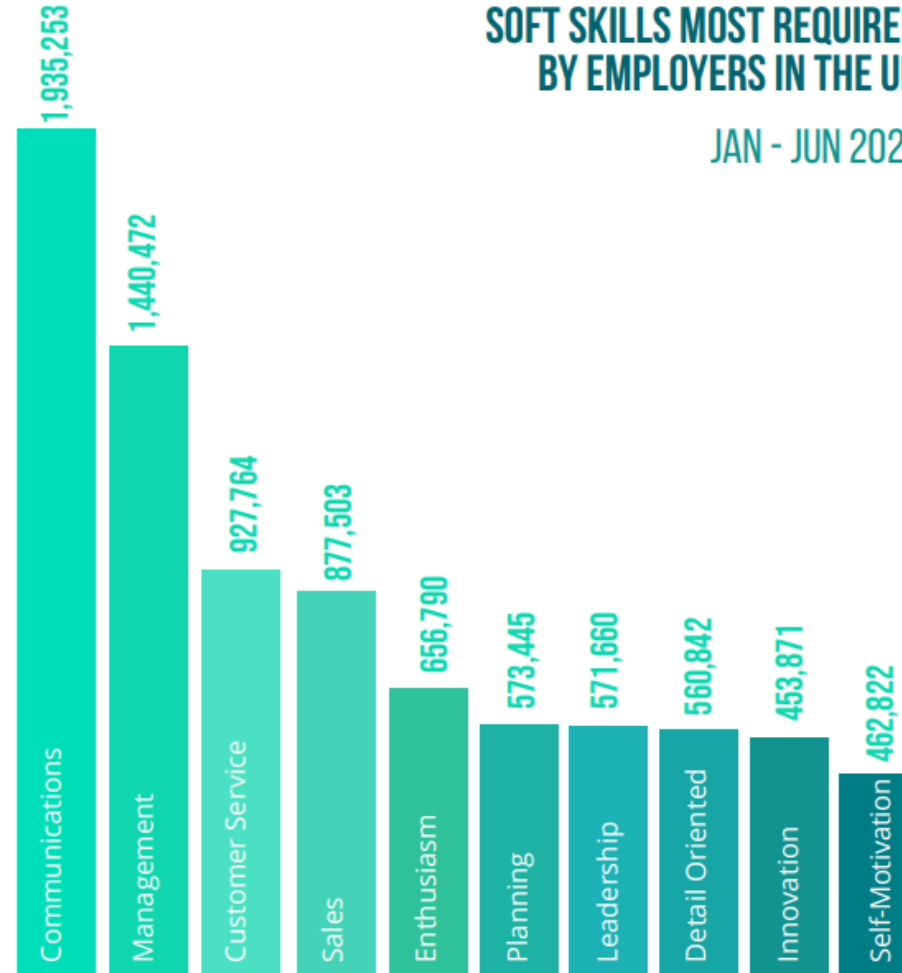
HARD SKILLS MOST REQUIRED BY EMPLOYERS IN THE UK

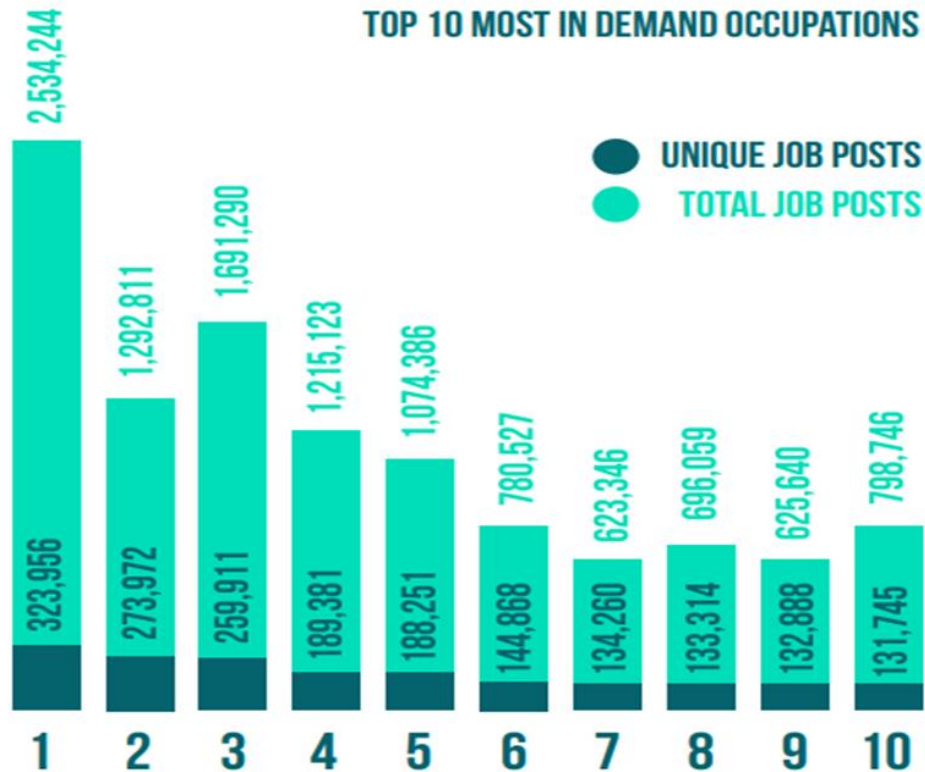

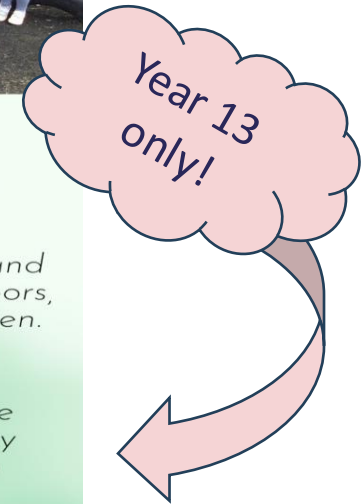


