Dear Parent/carer,

We were pleased to see so many parents and students at the transition evening last week.

We would like to clarify a few points regarding the transition days that are taking place on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> June (Robert Wilkinson and Huntington Primary) and Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> July (all other primary schools).

All students will need to make their own way to school and should arrive no earlier than 8:30am and no later than 8:45am. If pupils are being brought by car, then you will be able to enter the front drive from 8:30 (no earlier due to our school buses). The transition days will finish at 3pm, and pupils will make their own way home, please ensure you child knows how they are travelling home. If you are collecting by car, please do not use the front drive, you may use the astro turf car park opposite.

Students should wear their primary school uniform for the day and bring a **water bottle**, school bag and a pencil case. Students are welcome to bring a packed lunch or purchase a school lunch. If your child would like a school lunch, then please pay in advance via WisePay.

If you are purchasing a lunch the £3 offer will include the following:

- A dessert from the home bake section

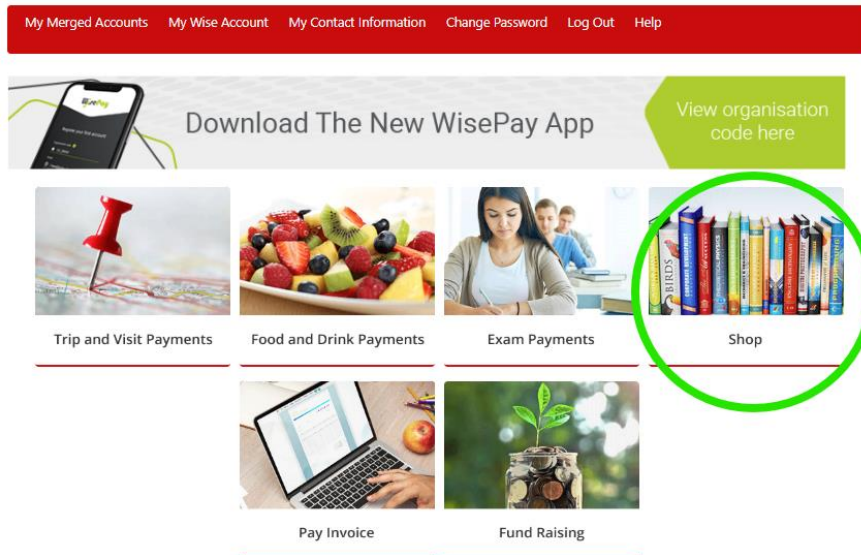

- A bottle of plain water

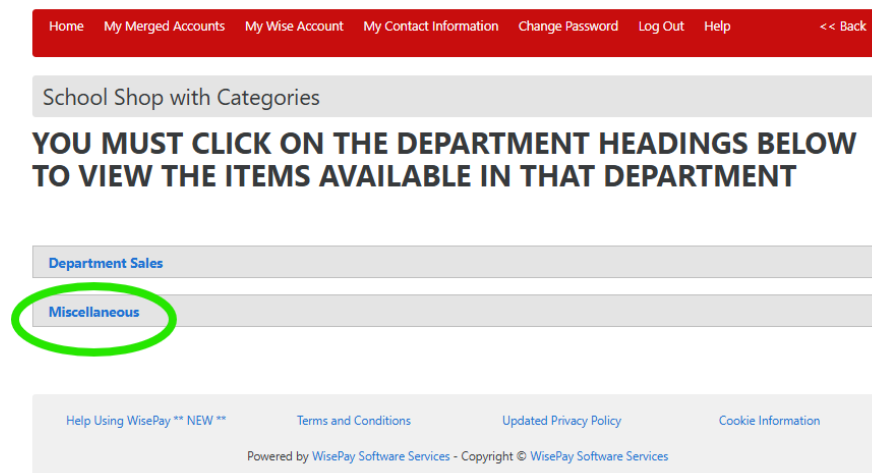
If you are eligible for free school meals or have any special dietary requirements, please let our canteen staff know at the cash register.


